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Cornerstone Christian School Dress Code



Cornerstone believes that appropriate attire encourages good student conduct and is fundamental to the development of wholesome attitudes and behavior. The school's intent is to maintain standards of godliness and excellence but not be legalistic and rigid. Students have a responsibility to dress neatly and appropriately.

- > The dress code is to be observed each day during the school year, including school programs, field trips, etc., unless the school has informed the parents otherwise.
- > Clothing must not be tight or form fitting. Jackets/coats are not to be worn in the classroom.
- No tattoos or piercings (except girls' ears) will be allowed.
- No hats, hoods, bandanas, scarves, or sunglasses are to be worn in the building.

Students not dressed according to dress code guidelines will be issued a Dress Code Violation and will remain in the office until appropriate clothing is brought to school.

The School Dress Code attire for Boys and Girls is as follows:

Pants/Slacks/Shorts: Navy, Black, or Tan (khaki) Uniform style - must fit properly at the waist. Baggy, too tight, or low-riding attire will not be permitted. A belt must be worn if there are belt loops and must be buckled at all times. Pants must be properly hemmed at shoe level and not dragging on the floor.

Dresses/Jumpers/Skirts: Navy, Black or Tan (khaki) <u>Must be knee length and modest in fit</u>. Leggings are permitted only when worn under dresses/skirts.

Shirts/Blouses: Navy, White, Red, Black or Light Blue Collared "Polo" style - long or short sleeve. Oxford cloth or cotton shirt/blouse - long or short fitted sleeves. Shirts must be tucked in at all times and only one top button may be left unbuttoned.

Turtlenecks: Navy, White, Red, Black, or Light Blue: Mock or regular style - long or short sleeved.

Sweaters/Sweater Vests: Navy, White, Red, Black, or Light Blue <u>May be worn over a shirt, blouse, or turtleneck</u>. Hooded zip-up jackets may be worn. Only solid colors (navy, white, red, black, or light blue) are allowed. No designs, logos or writing will be permitted.

Dress or Athletic Shoes: Shoes must be worn with socks or tights. No open-toed shoes, sandals, or flip-flops.

Gym Uniform: "Cornerstone Phys. Ed" T-shirt/sweatshirt, sweatpants, and shorts. <u>Shorts are for 6th – 8th grade students only</u>. Gym uniforms are to be purchased from the school and are to be worn on the student's gym day(s). Gym uniform shorts are to be worn only during gym class.

Hair: Clean, well groomed, and away from the eyes. Haircuts and hair colors are to be appropriate for school and not cause distraction or undue attention. Letters, symbols/signs cut into the hair are unacceptable.

Dress Down/Blue Jean Days: Dress code standards apply to all attire on blue jean/dress down days. In addition, ripped/torn blue jeans are allowed in moderation; large rips/tears and any skin exposure are not allowed.

THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE A FINAL DECISION ON ALL DRESS CODE MATTERS, INCLUDING CLOTHING AND HAIR.
