23-23 Dress Code

Cornerstone believes that appropriate attire encourages good student conduct and is fundamental to the development of wholesome attitudes and behavior. The school's intent is to maintain standards of godliness and excellence.

Students have a responsibility to dress neatly and appropriately.

- The dress code is to be observed each day during the school year, including school programs, field trips, etc., unless the school has informed the parents otherwise.
- Clothing must not be tight or form-fitting. Jackets/coats are not to be worn in the classroom.
- No tattoos or piercings (except girls' ears) will be allowed.
- No hats, hoods, bandanas, scarves, or sunglasses are to be worn in the building.

Students not dressed according to dress code guidelines will be issued a Dress Code Violation and will remain in the office until appropriate clothing is brought to school.

The School Dress Code attire for Boys and Girls is as follows:

- All dress code items, except shoes, must be purchased via our French Toast online store.
- All students must have 1 embroidered blazer to wear on chapel days and special events.
- All polos, sweaters, shirts, sweaters and blazers must have the school logo embroidery supplied by French Toast.
- Both girls and boys must purchase a tie to wear with collared shirts.
- Students are able to wear casual shoes
- Bottoms must fit properly at the waist. Baggy, too tight, or low-riding will not be permitted. A belt must be worn if there are belt loops and must be buckled at all times. Pants must be properly hemmed at shoe level and not dragging on the floor.
- Dresses/Skirts MUST BE KNEE LENGTH and modest in fit. Leggings are PERMITTED ONLY WHEN WORN UNDER DRESSES/SKIRTS.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times and only one top button may be left unbuttoned.
- Dress or athletic shoes are permitted and must be worn with socks, or tights. No open-toed shoes, sandals, or flip-flops or Crocs.
- "Cornerstone Phys. Ed" gym uniforms are to be worn on gym days only. Each registered student will received one uniform. Additional uniforms must be purchased at the school office.
- Hair is to be clean, well groomed, and away from the eyes. Haircuts and hair colors are to be appropriate for school and not cause distraction or undue attention.
- Letters, symbols/signs cut into the hair are unacceptable.
- Dress Down/Blue Jean Days: Dress code standards apply to all attire on blue jean/dress down days. In addition, ripped/torn blue jeans are allowed in moderation; large rips/tears and any skin exposure are not allowed.
