New Student Registration Process for Kindergarten through 8th Grade

New students entering grades 1st-8th at Cornerstone Christian School must provide the following academic records and meet certain requirements before beginning the registration process:

- ❖ 2.5 Grade Point Average
- ❖ Most recent achievement test results must show student testing at grade level
- ❖ Report card must show both semester (or current) grades
- ❖ Original Birth Certificate

Testing

Once the Student Testing Form is completed and the testing fee has been paid, a date is arranged for the entrance exam (grades 1 – 8) or Kindergarten screening. *(The Student Testing Fee is due at the time of the test date and payable with cash or money order only.)*

After the entrance exam or screening has been administered and evaluated, parents are notified of the student's admission status.

Completing Registration


Upon acceptance of enrollment, the following information is required:

- a. Registration Form completed and submitted with Registration Fee
- b. Request and Release for School Records Form signed
- c. School physical and dental forms
- d. Original Birth Certificate

Payments

The following payments are due on or before the dates listed below:

- Registration Fee is due with Enrollment Form
- Book Fees are due within 2 weeks of registration date.
- Student Administrative Fees are due by July 25.
- The first tuition payment for the school year is due August 1.
- EXTENDED DAY CARE (EDC) PAYMENTS ARE DUE ON THE 1st OF EACH MONTH (AUGUST – MAY).

 ***When registering after any of the above payment dates, fees are due upon student's acceptance to Cornerstone. Failure to adhere to payment requirements may result in delaying the student's start date.***
